



What is Honesty?

For each set of pictures, circle green if the actions are honest or circle red if they are dishonest.


1.  A girl with brown hair in pigtails, wearing a purple shirt and orange pants, is looking through a blue telescope mounted on a black stand.


Being honest means you tell the whole truth. If you hide the truth, you are not being honest.





Being honest means only doing things that are morally right. Taking things without paying for them is called stealing, and that is not right.
